Hacienda Hills Country Club Burglary; Suspect Arrested

The Villages, FL. – July 2, 2012

Sumter Sheriff's detectives have arrested a 34 year old Villages resident responsible for burglarizing Hacienda Hills Country Club located in the 1400 block of Morse Blvd. At approximately 6:33 a.m., Sumter deputies responded to Hacienda Hills Country Club after a maintenance worker arriving for work encountered the suspect in the parking lot. The suspect had a black shirt covering his hands and was holding the cash drawer that came from the restaurant located inside. The suspect fled in a vehicle but the maintenance worker provided deputies with a description of the suspect and his vehicle and the vehicle's tag number.

The suspect entered the country club by breaking the glass front doors. Inside, deputies found the cash register damaged and the glass broken out of a window to an office. The cash drawer was recovered from the parking lot. In all, the suspect caused about \$3,000 dollars damage.

Detective Brad Wasson located the vehicle's owner, Sean V. Sheehan, 34, at his place of employment. During an interview with Detective Wasson, Sheehan admitted to being at the country club and encountering the maintenance worker who reported the burglary but denied involvement in the burglary itself.

The suspect's vehicle was impounded and Sheehan consented to a search of the vehicle. Crime scene technicians processed the vehicle at the sheriff's office in Bushnell where technicians located glass remnants on the floor and seat as well as a black shirt that had glass shards on it inside the vehicle.

Sheehan was arrested without incident and transported to the Sumter County Detention Center where he is being held with no bond. Sheehan was charged with Burglary and Violation of Probation; he was on active probation out of Sumter County from a previous theft related charge.
