Bushnell Wal-Mart Theft Arrested

Bushnell, FL. – July 27, 2012

Sumter sheriff's detectives investigating recent thefts from the Bushnell Wal-Mart have arrested and charged two Citrus County residents with Felony Retail Theft.

On July 22, 2012, Christopher N. Jones, 20, of Inverness and Genevieve O. Davis, 19, of Hernando removed two Vizio 32 inch televisions, valued at more than \$400 dollars from the Bushnell Wal-Mart. Surveillance video captured the pair entering the store and placing the two televisions in a shopping cart before exiting the store without paying for the items. They left with the televisions driving an orange colored Dodge Neon.

Sumter sheriff's detectives were led to Ms. Davis after finding a 2005 Dodge Neon registered to her that matched the description seen leaving Wal-Mart in surveillance video.

On July 26, 2012, Sumter County detectives observed Jones and Davis in the Dodge Neon at the Inverness Wal-Mart and called Citrus County deputies for assistance. The pair was arrested at 8:10 p.m. by Citrus County deputies and taken to the Citrus County Detention Center. Sumter County Detective Brian Wilson interviewed the pair at the detention center and both confessed to committing the crimes. Both are being held on the charge of Felony Retail Theft with their bond set at \$2,000 dollars.

The investigation is ongoing and additional charges are anticipated.
