### Shop & Go Robbery

Webster, FL. – July 28, 2012

Sumter sheriff's detectives are investigating a Robbery that occurred Saturday, July 28, 2012 at the Shop & Go on N. Market Street in Webster.

On July 28, 2012 at about 10:25 p.m., two suspects, one armed with a silver semi-automatic pistol, entered the store demanding cash from the cashier. Afterwards, both suspects fled the store on foot. Sheriff's K9's were called in and tracked the suspects west along CR 478 before losing the suspect's scent.



Suspect #1 is described as approximately 6'0" tall, muscular build, weighing 170-180 pounds wearing black shorts, black athletic shoes, and a red hoodie. Suspect #1 had a blue bandanna covering his lower facial area and was armed with a silver semi-automatic handgun.

Suspect# 2 is described as a heavysset black male approximately 5'8" tall, weighing 210-220 pounds wearing all black clothing that consisted of long black pants, black hoodie, black shoes, and a black bandanna that covered his lower facial area.

There were two cashiers on duty at the time and neither was injured. Sumter detectives are investigating similarities between this robbery and the July 24<sup>th</sup> robbery of the Circle K in Nobleton. Surveillance video of the robberies have been posted on the sheriff's website for public viewing. Callers can remain anonymous and may be eligible for a reward of up to \$1,000 dollars.
