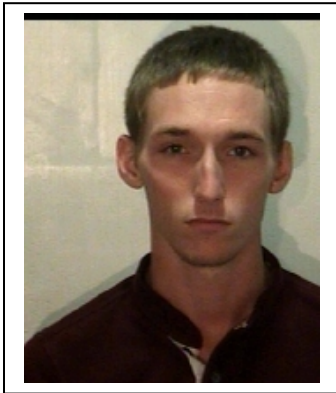

More Wal-Mart Theft Arrests

Bushnell, FL. – August 2, 2012



Sumter County detectives have made more arrests in a recent string of theft related incidents occurring at the Bushnell Wal-Mart. On August 2, 2012, two more Citrus County residents were arrested and charged with stealing two televisions.

John T. Sarver, 20, of Inverness, and an unidentified 16 year-old were arrested at the Sumter County Sheriff's Office after agreeing to meet with detectives. Both admitted to the thefts and were taken to the Sumter County Detention Center. Both were charged with Felony Retail Theft; Sarver's bond was set \$4,000 dollars and the juvenile was processed internally and released to a parent.

Sarver was involved in thefts from Wal-Mart occurring on July 19th and July 22nd, and are unrelated to the July 24th thefts where Genevieve Davis and Christopher Jones were arrested and previously charged with. Davis' and Jones' involvement in this incident remains under investigation. Surveillance video captured the theft as it occurred, showing the suspects placing the televisions into a shopping cart and leaving the store without paying for the items.

The investigation is ongoing and additional arrests are anticipated.
