## Lake Panasoffkee Burglary Suspects Arrested

Lake Panasoffkee, FL. – August 13, 2012



Two Lake Panasoffkee residents have been arrested and charged with breaking into eight Lake Panasoffkee storage units.

Sumter sheriff's detectives arrested Dale E. Clark, 22, and Jake E. Jeter, 24, both of Lake Panasoffkee on Friday, August 10, 2012 after determining the pair was responsible for the early morning burglary at Chandler's Storage located in the 1900 block of N. CR 470.

Clark and Jeter used a pair of bolt cutters to cut a hole in the fence surrounding the property and then cut the locks off of eight individual units that were entered. The pair stole two flat screen televisions, a guitar, an amplifier, electric tools and other miscellaneous items. After the burglary was reported to deputies, detectives made contact with both subjects, and through their cooperation, detectives were able to recover all of the stolen items.

Clark was charged with 7 counts of Burglary, 8 counts of Criminal Mischief, and 1 count of Grand Theft. Jeter was charged with 7 counts of Burglary, 8 counts of Criminal Mischief, 1 count of Grand Theft, 1 count of Possession of Burglary Tools, and 1 count of Wearing a Bulletproof Vest During the Commission of a Crime; Jeter wore a bulletproof vest during the burglary. Both were taken to the Sumter County Detention Center.
