Villages Man Faces Lewd Conduct Charges

The Villages, FL. – September 4, 2012



A Villages resident is facing lewd conduct charges after Sheriff's Detectives investigated a complaint the man grabbed a 15 year old girl at Lake Sumter Landing. Jaime Greenberg, 39, of The Villages was arrested by Sheriff's Detectives on August 31, 2012. He is charged with one count of Lewd and Lascivious Conduct; his bond was set at \$5,000 dollars.

On August 25, 2012, the parents of the 15 year old female victim reported that a male suspect grabbed their daughter as she was walking on a path at Lake Sumter Landing. The victim, who was alone at the time, was walking on a path near the playground in the southwest section of the landing. The male suspect approached the girl from behind, grabbed her, and held her in a "bear hug" like hold until she was able to free herself from his grasp; the suspect then fled the area on foot.

The reporting Deputy recognized the description as that of Greenberg who he knows frequents the area. After filing the report, the victim identified Greenberg as the person who grabbed her after viewing Florida's sex offender website from her home computer. Sheriff's Detectives arrested Greenberg at his residence on August 31, 2012.

Greenberg was taken to the Sumter County Detention Center and was released after posting \$5,000 dollar bond. In 2009, he registered as a sex offender with the Sumter County Sheriff's Office. In 2002, he was convicted of a sex offense against a female less than 16 years of age in Nassau County, NY.
