On Thursday 09/12/13, at approximately 17:42 hours, the Sumter County Sheriff's office received a complaint of a suspect photographing and touching a female customer at Wal-Mart located at 2163 West CR- 48. The suspect was later identified as Lance Douglas Windisch. On Tuesday 09/17/13, at approximately 20:11 hours, a Sumter County Deputy made contact with Windisch in the parking lot of the same Wal-Mart location. During the encounter, the suspect fled the parking lot in his vehicle and after a brief pursuit; Windisch abandoned his vehicle at the Roadway Inn and fled on foot. During the pursuit, the suspect placed his vehicle in reverse and rammed the front of a Deputy's marked patrol vehicle.

After an exhaustive search using K-9 from the Sumter County Sheriff's Office and the Sumter Correctional Institution and Aviation units from Sumter and Citrus counties. The suspect was not located. The Sumter County Sheriff's Office has obtained arrest warrants for Lance Douglas Windisch for the following charges: Aggravated Battery (LEO), Resisting (without violence), Fleeing/Elude Police Officer, and D.W.L.S. Windisch is consider dangerous and has a criminal history involving Battery on Law Enforcement Officer.
