VILLAGES BURGLARIES

On July 29, 2015 at 2:42 AM, a Daily Sun paper courier reported to a Village Community Watch a suspicious vehicle (Red Mazda 6) and two suspicious male subjects in the area. Village Community Watch contacted the Sumter County Sheriff's Office and within six minutes eight deputies were in the area BOLO-ing for the suspects/vehicle which was last seen north bound on Buena Vista Blvd.

We received additional information from the Village Community Watch; they spotted one of the subjects behind a residence at the intersection of Davit Place and Banning Ct. At 2:48 AM deputies stopped the suspects' vehicle on Buena Vista Blvd. and Turnberry Ln. The occupant/driver of the vehicle, Troy Duval Hagins Jr, DOB: 06/13/96 was detained and eventually arrested for loitering and prowling. Inside the vehicle deputies discovered two handguns, marijuana under 20 grams, and a bottle of hydrocodone.

At 8:00AM The Sumter County Sheriff's Office received a vehicle burglary report from Nash Loop in the Villages. Canvassing the area, deputies discovered four vehicles

that were broken into on Nash Loop. Additional vehicles were broken in the same area, of The Village of Mariel. The two handguns that were discovered in the suspects' vehicle were likely stolen from two Villages residents' vehicles; the bottle of hydrocodone was also stolen from a Villages residents' golf cart. At 8:35 AM Leesburg Police Department discovered an abandoned Mercury Marquee. The owner of this vehicle who resides on Camden Terrace, in the Villages was contacted. The owner at this time discovered/reported the vehicle stolen. The Ford Fusion was reported this morning as being stolen from Eustis, FL. The owner of this vehicle, Manuel Guzman DOB: 02/08/1996 was interviewed by Sumter County Sheriff's Office, Villages Detectives. Detectives questioned Guzman because one of the victims' home security camera system identified him at the scene around his vehicle. Guzman confessed to falsely reporting his car stolen and being part of this crime spree.

Grand Theft \$300 or more less than \$20,000 1ct Bond: \$5,000
