On June 14, 2016, deputies responded to the 9400 block of SW 17th Way in Bushnell in reference a stolen vehicle from Marion County there. When deputies arrived, the suspect, Felipe Madrigal, fled in the vehicle South on U.S. Hwy 301 toward Hernando County. Sumter deputies attempted to stop the vehicle using emergency lights and sirens, but Madrigal failed to yield and fled from deputies at a high rate of speed. Deputies did not pursue the vehicle.

With the assistance of the victim, Deputies were lead to the area of CR 754 in Webster where the vehicle was recovered. The Sheriff's Aviation Unit and Bloodhound Teams from the Sheriff's detention center responded in an effort to locate the suspect. Cpl. Justin Brannen and Bloodhound K9 Libby tracked and located Madrigal hiding in a vehicle on CR 748 after an approximate one hour search.

Flee/Elude Police-Fail to obey LEO order to stop Bond: 25000.00

Operating a motor vehicle w/o a valid license Bond: 500.00
