

Suspects Charged in Wildwood Hotel Robbery

Wildwood (06/28/2016) – Two suspects are facing False Imprisonment and Robbery charges in connection with a Wildwood hotel robbery.

Kenquieana Clark, 20, and Deontae Brown, 19, both of Orlando have been arrested and charged with Battery, False Imprisonment and Robbery after stealing money from a man's wallet on June 25, 2016 at the Economy Inn on E. SR 44 in Wildwood.

In the early morning hours of June 25, 2016, the victim was held up by Brown, who was believed to be armed with a knife, in the hotel hallway. Clark was able to remove the victim's wallet from his pants pocket and stole the cash contained therein. After a brief struggle, the victim was able to break free from Brown and Clark and summoned law enforcement.

Brown was arrested on the day of the robbery due to out-standing warrants issued for his arrest. The following day, both suspects were identified by the victim after viewing a photo line-up. Additional charges of Battery, False Imprisonment and Robbery were added on June 27, 2016 while he was in custody at the Sumter County Detention Center; his bond is \$31,700.

After being identified by the victim, Clark was located and arrested without incident on June 27, 2016 at about 5:54PM. She is now being held at the Sumter County Detention Center also; her bond is \$10,500.
