Armed Robbery-Burger King

The Sumter County Sheriff's Office is investigating an armed robbery that occurred today, April 27, 2019, at approximately 7:30 am, at Burger King 3630 Wedgewood Lane, the Villages, FL. Three employees and one customer were present at the time of the robbery. The suspects emptied the cash registers fleeing with an undisclosed amount of money.

The suspects are described as two black males, one wearing tan pants, black shoes, a black sweater and a red shirt wrapped around his head. The second suspect was described as wearing dark blue jeans, sneakers, a white hoodie and checkered boxers hanging out of his pants. The suspects possibly fled the area in a tan Buick Sunfire with a black top, last seen in the area of CR 103 near Burger King.

The Sumter County Sheriff's office believes the suspects are no longer in the area, however they are considered armed and dangerous.
