Villages Burger King Robbery – Update

On Saturday April 27, 2019 at around 1:43 p.m., a uniformed Sheriff's Office Patrol Sergeant located the suspect vehicle from the early morning armed robbery of the Burger King located at 3630 Wedgewood Lane, The Villages, Florida.

The investigation by deputies identified the suspect vehicle as a silver Chrysler Sebring black top convertible and this vehicle was ultimately located on Warm Springs Ave. in Coleman, Florida. When deputies attempted to stop the suspect vehicle, the driver fled recklessly at a high rate of speed. A high speed chase ensued due to the violent nature of the armed robbery.

As the pursuit entered the intersection of S.R. 44 at Morse Blvd, the driver of the Chrysler Sebring rammed a sheriff's office patrol car and became disabled. There were four occupants in the suspect vehicle, two of which were juveniles. One adult suspect was taken into custody at the scene. One juvenile and one adult suspect did require medical attention from the car crash and were treated at The Villages Regional Hospital and Leesburg Regional Medical Center. None of the injuries were life threatening. No deputies were injured in the pursuit and crash.

The relationship and involvement of the remaining adult and two juveniles, ages 17 and 14, is still under investigation by detectives. The adult suspect was booked into the Sumter County Detention Center.

The Sheriff's Office has not been able to locate or identify the customer in the Burger King at the time of the robbery. He is described as an older white male and he left the Burger King before deputies arrived on scene.
