Melvin Miller (5/13/82), and Trynity Mack (5/3/87), were both arrested yesterday February 25, 2020, by members of the Sumter County Sheriff's Office after responding to their residence on CR 690, in reference to a Child Abuse call for service.

Deputies responded to the address along with DCF to investigate a complaint of Child Abuse. After a thorough investigation, Deputies found six children living within the home and developed probable cause to arrest Melvin and Trynity on six counts of Child Neglect and two counts of Child Abuse.

A search warrant was requested and obtained for the residence, and after serving the search warrant, Melvin and Trynity were additionally charged with, Possession of Ammo by a Convicted Felon, Possession of Methamphetamine, and Possession of Marijuana less than 20 grams.

Melvin was also arrested on an active Writ of Bodily Attachment for Failure to Pay Child Support.

Both are being held at the Sumter County Detention Center under a No Bond.
