Felony Arrest

On February 28, 2019, at approximately 12:11 P.M. a Deputy with the Sumter County Sheriff's Office attempted a traffic stop in the area of the Powell Community Center within the City limits of Wildwood on a black Nissan passenger car. The Deputy positively identified the driver as Zantrell Laquan Jackson (09/14/1994), an individual known to the Deputy to have multiple active Sumter County Warrants. Zantrell Jackson then fled from the traffic stop in the vehicle leading Sumter County Deputies on a high-speed pursuit throughout the city and into rural areas of Sumter County. Once in a safe location, the Deputy initiated a Precision Immobilization Technique (PIT maneuver) on the vehicle in the area of CR 229 and CR 466, resulting in the immobilization of the vehicle. Zantrell Jackson was taken into custody for numerous felony warrants as well as additional charges including Aggravated Flee / Allude, Child Abuse, and Driving While License Suspended / Revoked. At the time of the incident deputies discovered a small child approximately 4 years of age was a passenger within the vehicle.

The Deputy who initiated the stop had previous knowledge of Zantrell Jackson having numerous active Sumter County Warrants and has been actively pursued by law enforcement for over 8 months. The Deputy was also familiar with numerous non-charged incidents involving firearms and threats of violence with Zantrell Jackson listed as the suspect. Zantrell Jackson's active warrants are for the following charges:

Aggravated assault on law enforcement, aggravated fleeing and elude, possession of a

firearm/ammunition by a felon, resisting law enforcement with violence, driving while license suspended and criminal mischief

Order to revoke bond for felony fleeing to elude, resisting without violence, and driving while license suspended

4 FTA warrants for sale of cocaine, possession of cocaine with intent to sell, and unlawful use of a two communication device.

Zantrell Jackson was taken into custody and transported to the Sumter County Detention Center under no bond status. Further charges are forthcoming pending further investigation. The deputy involved received minor injuries during the incident.
