Wildwood- Search Warrant Arrest

On June 30, 2020, at approximately 12:09 pm, members of the Sumter County Sheriff's Office Special Investigations Squad executed a narcotics search warrant at a residence located at 9300 CR 125B Wildwood, Sumter County, Florida. The search warrant was the result of a two-month-long investigation at the above location due to numerous complaints of suspicious vehicles, persons, and suspicious activity related to possible narcotic sales. The suspect of the investigation, Lance Hanson, who was present during the execution of the search warrant, was immediately detained outside of the residence. During the time he was detained, he discarded a bag of suspected methamphetamine and a bag of prescription medication onto the ground as Detectives made contact with him.

Upon execution of the search warrant, Detectives discovered numerous control substances and drug paraphernalia within Lance Hanson's bedroom that was locked, he was in sole possession of the key to the room. During the search, Detectives discovered approximately 58.32 grams of heroin; 14.89 grams of methamphetamine; 134.73 grams of marijuana; 34.05 grams (85 tablets which includes the tablets found outside) Suboxone; less than 1 gram of LSD, a small amount of THC oil; several items of paraphernalia including baggies and scales for packaging consistent with selling narcotics, numerous pipes and pieces of burnt aluminum foil used for smoking narcotics.

During a further search of the residence, Detectives located more marijuana, prescription medication

(Adderall), and drug paraphernalia. Detectives identified two other occupants residing in another bedroom within the residence, later identified as Charles McCullough and Camille Keller who later arrived on scene.

Lance Hanson, Charles McCullough, and Camille Keller were arrested on scene and transported to the Sumter County Detention Center. Charges and bonds are as follows:

Lance Hanson

- Trafficking methamphetamine
- Trafficking heroin
- Possession of marijuana with intent to sell
- Possession of Buprenorphine (Suboxone) with the intent to sell
- Possession hallucinogen (LSD) with the intent to sell
- Rental or possession of a structure for trafficking or manufacturing a controlled substance
- Possession of control substance (THC oil)
- Possession drug paraphernalia

Bond \$70,000.00

Charles McCullough

- Possession of marijuana under 20 grams
- Possession drug paraphernalia

Bond \$2,000.00

Camille Keller

- Possession of control substance

Bond \$2,000.00
