



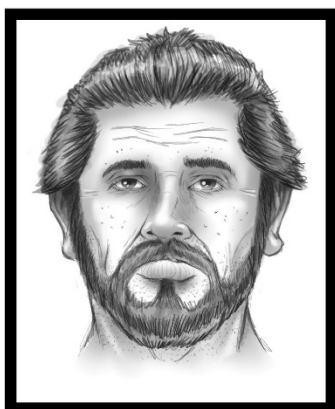

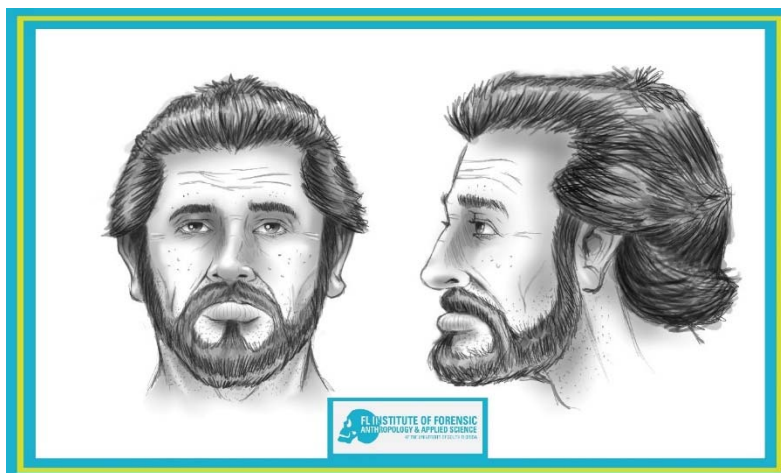

Unidentified Deceased Male



Facial Approximation 



Human remains were found in an abandoned home in Bushnell, Florida on November 28, 2020. Detectives began an investigation, during the investigation they found no reason to believe the male died under suspicious circumstances. The male is described as being 50 years or older, white European male, approximately 5'6" to 6'1/2". He had significant tooth loss and significant Osteoarthritis and spinal degeneration. He would have a noticeable deformation to the nose caused by bilateral fractures (crooked nose). The decedent was wearing Lee Brand Jeans and brand new generic gray, Velcro-type sneakers.

The remains were sent out for DNA analysis, and a facial reconstruction through USF's Florida Institute of Forensic Anthropology & Applied Science. At this time investigative efforts have been exhausted and we are seeking the public's assistance identifying this gentleman.
